

## HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

### THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING AND TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN VARIOUS ROADS IN NORTH MYMMS, HATFIELD AND SMALLFORD) ORDER 2022

NOTICE is given that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using the following lengths of roads (“the Roads”), except for access and to prohibit all vehicles from waiting at any time on both sides of these lengths of Roads whilst works are in progress:-

1. that length of Bradmore Lane, North Mymms from its junction with Station Road south westwards, north westwards and south westwards to its junction with Warrengate Road, a distance of approximately 1266 metres.

An alternative route will be via Station Road, Dixons Hill Road, Swanland Road and Warrengate Road.

2. that length of Wilkins Green Lane, Hatfield from its junction with Ellenbrook Lane south westwards for a distance of approximately 177 metres.

An alternative route will be via Ellenbrook Lane, A1057 (St Albans Road West/Hatfield Road) and Wilkins Green Lane.

3. that length of Wilkins Green Lane, Smallford from its junction with A1057 Hatfield Road south eastwards for a distance of approximately 219 metres.

An alternative route will be via A1057 (Hatfield Road/St Albans Road West), Ellenbrook Lane and Wilkins Green Lane.

The Order is needed because works are proposed to be executed on or near the Roads.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 24 October 2022 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Roads.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
