a) Planning

Comments have been submitted onto the Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council planning portal on 14 planning applications.

b) Property

c) Temporary Road Closures/Temporary Footpath Closures

THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING AND TEMPORARY WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN DIXONS HILL ROAD, HATFIELD) ORDER 2024

Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using the following lengths of roads ("the Roads"), except for access and to prohibit all vehicles from waiting at any time on both sides of these lengths of Roads whilst works are in progress:-

1. that length of Dixons Hill Road, Hatfield from a point in line with the eastern boundary of No.15 Dixons Hill Road north eastwards for a distance of approximately 65m.

An alternative route will be via Dixons Hill Road, Dellsome Lane, Station Road, Bulls Lane, Holloways Lane and Dixons Hill Road.
